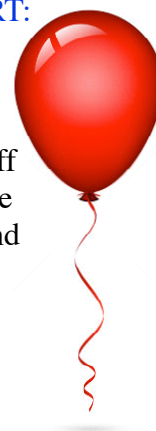

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Dodie reported that our balance on hand on April 8, 2014 was \$4,016.74. Income was \$730.00 and expenses were \$792.50, leaving a balance on hand of \$3,954.24 on May 13, 2014. The Certificate of Deposit is \$6,000.00. SDWC still has \$400.00 to donate by June. Dodie asked for members to choose which organizations we would like to give a donation to.

Motions were made and passed unanimously to give a \$200 donation to the Mira Costa College Scholarship Fund, and also \$200 plus proceeds from the "White Elephant Sale" to Veterans Village of San Diego.

**1ST VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT:**

Linda asked members to turn in their volunteer hours. She also thanked members for volunteering at the Encinitas Gardens and the Off Track Gallery events. Helen had the most volunteer hours this month and was given a balloon.



**MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN:** Candace asked for items to be donated for next year's pin drawings. Loni won the pin drawing.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Kathleen asked for help with sewing the holiday runners and coasters.

\*Arleen asked members to bring clothing accessories for the White Elephant Sale at the June Jubilee. Some suggestions were gently used scarves or purses.

\*Dodie stated that the Arden Street garage sale was cancelled. She asked members to think about whether we would like to do it ourselves next year.

\*Bestina will be installing the new officers at the Jubilee and members that have been with the club for 10 or more years will be honored.

The Collect was recited and the meeting was adjourned at 12:05 p.m..
